

Traveling information

Transportation from Frankfurt Airport to Heidelberg

Heidelberg is located in the Rhine-Neckar region, about 100 km south of Frankfurt/Main. The train ride from Frankfurt airport to Heidelberg takes about one hour and involves changing trains in Mannheim. A one-way ticket costs approx. € 30. For timetables and fares see:

If you travel in small groups, the most convenient way to get to Heidelberg is to order a private mini shuttle bus for up to 7 people run by the company TLS. Transportation within Heidelberg

The event location is on the University Campus *Im Neuenheimer Feld*. The nearest hotels are around the central railway station. Coming from the central railway station (*Hauptbahnhof*) you can reach the venue by taking either the **bus line 20** (direction: *Neuenheim, Sportzentrum Nord*) or the **bus line 32** (direction: *Neuenheim, Kopfklinik*) and exiting at stop **Campus Im Neuenheimer Feld** (it takes app. 10 min).

Please contact the hotels directly to find out the price. The price for a single room is usually between 70 and 80 euros; breakfast is available for 16 to 17 euros.

To reduce accommodation costs, students may look for a roommate. Twin rooms/apartments (two single beds) are available in both hotels.

Another possibility would be to look for an accommodation in a **hostel** or to form a small group with other participants and look for an apartment together.
